The Chinese Proficiency Tests (Hanyu Shuiping Kaoshi, or HSK) is a standardized international Chinese language test to measure the ability of non-native Chinese speakers to communicate in Chinese in daily lives, academic and working settings. We offer training courses from HSK level 1 to level 6. The course focuses on the Chinese language expression ability of participants through comprehensive language teaching. It is aimed at progressing the logical application of Chinese, as well as achieving a higher level of verbal skills, written skills (and good results in the HSK test). Meanwhile, learners will also be able to gain knowledge of China, one of the world's first civilizations, and Chinese culture. The course will be taught by English-speaking teachers from China here at the Technical University in Zvolen! Other Chinese courses can also be offered according to interest.
